**HKU MUSEUM SOCIETY TRAVEL GRANTS  
FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS IN FINE ARTS**

March 9, 2017

Through the generosity of the University of Hong Kong Museum Society, several grants are available each academic year to support undergraduate student travel outside Hong Kong to view art in museum collections or other locations, or to undertake art-related internship programmes.

**Number and amount of grants.** Several grants will be awarded each year, for a combined total of about HK\$20,000. Subject to approval in advance, the grants shall be used to cover the costs of air and local travel, accommodation, and other relevant expenses incurred during the trip (such as museum entry charges). Grant amounts usually range between \$2,000 and \$8,000, to be decided by the Selection Committee.

**Eligibility and timing.** Grants are open to undergraduate students in year 2 or above who are majoring in Fine Arts. Travel must be completed prior to the end of the student's undergraduate studies (usually June 30 for graduating students). A student can only be awarded this Grant once during his/her period of study at HKU.

**Selection process and criteria.** Grants will be awarded based on academic excellence and the importance of the travel plan to the student's study. The selection committee is composed of three full-time teachers from the Department of Fine Arts.

**Responsibilities of successful applicants.** On completion of travel, each grant recipient must submit a report including an account of the use of the award money to the Department of Fine Arts. Original receipts should be submitted to verify completion of travel. Failure to account for the proper use of the funds may lead to withdrawal of the award money.

**Application procedure and deadline.** There is one application form for all travel grants, obtainable in the Fine Arts general office (Room 1033, Run Run Shaw Tower). Completed applications, together with supporting documents, shall be submitted to the same office by **5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 31, 2017.**

**ARTS AND EDUCATION TRAVEL GRANTS  
FOR FINE ART STUDENTS**

Thanks to a generous continuing donation to the Department of Fine Arts from the Arts and Education Limited, funding is available to support student travel. Terms of the grant programme are below.

**Eligible types of travel.** This grant supports travel for art history students with limited financial resources to view works of art first hand and/or to visit archives, libraries, or other overseas facilities and events of significant educational merit.

**Eligible applicants.** Grants are available to *undergraduate majors in Fine Arts* (in the second year or above) and to *postgraduate students in Fine Arts*. Travel must be completed prior to the end of the student's studies (usually June 30 for graduating undergraduates).

**Amount of awards.** There is no prescribed limit for the number or amount of individual grants, but grant amounts usually range between \$1,000 and \$8,000.

**Selection process and criteria.** Grants will be awarded based on three essential criteria: (1) academic ability; (2) merit of the grant proposal; and (3) financial need. The selection committee is composed of teachers in the Department of Fine Arts.

**Requirements.** Successful applicants must submit original receipts to verify that they have spent the grant money on approved costs. *By accepting a grant, the student further agrees to write a brief report following the trip to explain the benefits of his/her trip, and subsequently to meet with the donor, if requested, to report verbally on the trip.*

**Application procedure and deadline.** There is one application form for all travel grants, obtainable in the Fine Arts general office (Room 1033, Run Run Shaw Tower). Completed applications, together with supporting documents, shall be submitted to the same office by **5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 31, 2017.**

**THE MAGDELINE LOR GRANTS  
FOR FINE ARTS STUDENTS**

March 9, 2017

Thanks to a special endowment fund established by Ms. Magdeline Lor, funding is available to support Fine Arts students with limited financial resources who wish to complete a project, conduct research, go on a field trip, or attend a conference.

**Eligible activities.** Any of the above-mentioned activities are eligible, as long as they have a clear academic purpose.

**Eligible applicants.** Grants are available to undergraduate students in their first year of study taking at least 12 credits of Fine Arts courses, students in their second year or above taking at least 24 credits of 2000-/3000-/4000-level Fine Arts courses, and postgraduate students registered in the Department of Fine Arts.

**Amount of awards.** Individual grants shall normally range from \$500 to a maximum of \$7,000. Group projects may be considered for extra funding.

**Criteria of selection.** Grants will be awarded based on three essential criteria: (1) academic ability; (2) merit of the grant proposal; and (3) financial need. The selection committee is composed of the Chairperson of the Dept. of Fine Arts, a teacher from the Dept. of Fine Arts, and the Dean of Student Affairs.

**Responsibilities of successful applicants.** Successful applicants must submit original receipts to verify that they have spent the grant money on approved costs. Those costs must be paid before the expiration of one's student status; for example, if this is your last semester of study, only costs paid by June 30 are reimbursable.

**Application procedure and deadline.** There is one application form for all travel grants, obtainable in the Fine Arts general office (Room 1033, Run Run Shaw Tower). Completed applications, together with supporting documents, shall be submitted to the same office by **5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 31, 2017.**

**HKU MUSEUM SOCIETY TRAVEL GRANTS  
FOR RESEARCH POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS IN FINE ARTS**

March 9, 2017

Through the generosity of the University of Hong Kong Museum Society, two annual grants are available to support travel expenses of research postgraduate students in the Department of Fine Arts who need to conduct research overseas.

**Number and amount of grants.** Two grants are available each academic year, with a combined value of HK\$20,000. One grant is for a student studying any area of Asian art history, while the other is open to all students in the Department of Fine Arts, regardless of their area of specialty. Subject to approval in advance, the grant shall be used to cover the costs of air and local travel, accommodation, and other relevant expenses incurred during the trip (such as museum entry charges).

**Eligibility and timing.** All Research Postgraduate Students in the Department of Fine Arts are eligible to apply for the Grants during their normative study period, for travel to be completed prior to the end of that period. A student can only be awarded this grant once during his/her candidature.

**Selection process and criteria.** Grants will be awarded based on academic excellence and the importance of the travel plan to the student's study. The selection committee is composed of three full-time teachers from the Department of Fine Arts.

**Responsibilities of successful applicants.** On completion of the trip, each grant recipient must submit a report including an account of the use of the award money to the Department of Fine Arts. Original receipts should be submitted to verify completion of travel. Failure to account for the proper use of the funds may lead to withdrawal of the award money.

**Application procedure and deadline.** There is one application form for all travel grants, obtainable in the Fine Arts general office (Room 1033, Run Run Shaw Tower). Completed applications, together with supporting documents, shall be returned to the same office by **5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 31, 2017.**
