This exciting 18-month programme offers 10 outstanding graduates the chance to experience our business through a series of placements, spot rotations and workshops. Each Graduate Trainee will be offered a competitive salary and will have the exclusive opportunity to be mentored by experienced business leaders. Participants will gain a comprehensive understanding of Christie's, heightened commercial awareness and advanced specialist skills. We aim to retain all of our Graduate Trainees - the next generation of Christie's business leaders.

A Trainee will complete a series of rotations with both specialist departments and key support departments.
